## LOG HOUSE

The oldest building on the grounds, built in the mid 1840s, the Log House is preserved as a museum and welcomes visitors in the summer for touring, candle making, quilting, rug looming and stories.

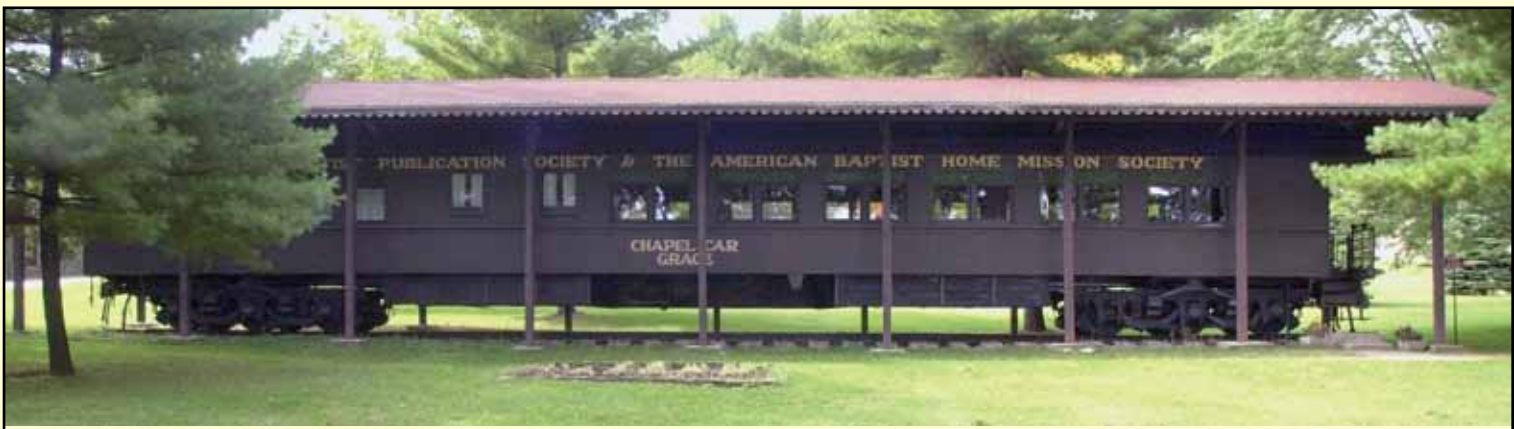
## MEMORY LANE

Enjoy beautiful views of Green Lake as you stroll along Memory Lane from Roger Williams Inn to the Vesper Circle.



## JUDSON TOWER AND PRAYER TOWERS

Climb the 121 steps up Judson Tower for a breathtaking view of Green Lake and the conference center. In addition to Judson Tower, there are five smaller towers throughout the grounds to explore.



## CHAPEL CAR GRACE

Beautifully restored Chapel Car Grace was used for missionary work in the west from 1914-46. Includes a church which seats 50 in oak pews, a pastor's bedroom, living room, kitchen and bathroom.



## NO HURRY BOAT

This battery powered boat was built for Victor and Jessie Lawson in 1905. Only two others like it were built, one for Thomas Edison and one for a Russian Czar. A wooden ramp leads to an area for viewing the inside of the restored boat.

# FUN WAYS TO STRETCH YOUR LEGS



## WALKS: DAWSON PRAIRIE, SHORE DRIVE, HAMMER'S TRAIL AND WINNEBAGO TRAIL

Dawson Prairie encompasses 54 acres of restored land. Mowed trails wind through over 100 species of native grasses and wildflowers, blooming late spring through September. Abundant wildlife including deer, birds and butterflies inhabit the prairie. A walk on Shore Drive takes you along the lake and past stately houses.

Hammer's Trail is a wooded hike that begins in the Tea House area. Winnebago Trail, originally used by the Winnebago Indians, follows the shoreline and begins near the Teen water tower.



## DISC GOLF

Disc Golf is a sport in which individual players throw a flying disc (similar to a Frisbee®) into a metal basket. Scored like a traditional golf game, it is fun for all ages and requires no tee times! It's a great walk with great scenery and the only equipment needed is a disc (available at Green Lake). The nine hole course begins near Robbins South Hall.

## PLAYGROUNDS

Endless fun for kids on an ark, swings and slides! Playgrounds are located near C. Oscar Johnson, Anderson Campground, Children's Center and Friendship Beach.



## BIKING

Rent a bike and ride along Shore Drive for beautiful views and historic lakeshore houses...or ride on our tree-lined roads. Bike rentals are available from the Boat House Memorial Day to Labor Day.

# SPORTS, LAKEFRONT & BOAT RENTALS



## **FRIENDSHIP BEACH**

Swim in the lake and build a sand castle at Friendship Beach. Swimming is at your own risk; no lifeguard on duty.

Enjoy soda or an ice cream treat at the **SNAK SHAK** next to the beach. Open in summer.

## **BOAT HOUSE**

Open Memorial Day through Labor Day. Enjoy the lake on a pontoon, canoe, kayak or paddleboat.

## **OUTDOOR TENNIS AND BASKETBALL**

Three tennis courts and one basketball court are available.



## **BASEBALL, FOOTBALL, SOCCER AND HORSESHOES**

A sports field, including a baseball diamond, is located near the tennis courts. Horseshoe pits are located near Tower View camping circle.

## **OUTDOOR VOLLEYBALL**

Next to Chapel Car Grace, C. Oscar Johnson Center, Anderson Campground, and the Tea House.

## **CARPETBALL**

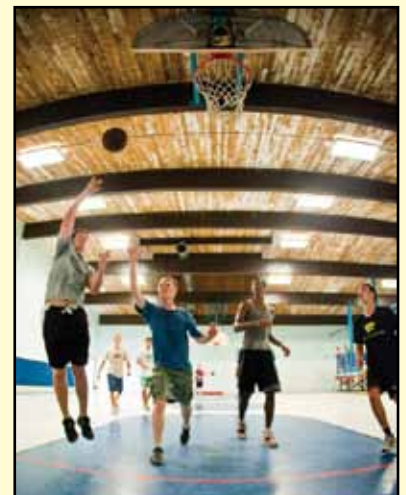

## SPURGEON CHAPEL

An historic chapel, built in 1904 as a root cellar by the Lawsons. The chapel's benches seat 75. You are invited to visit for quiet meditation, and to leave prayer requests on the altar.



## PADELFORD COUNTRY STORE

Located in the campground, this quaint store features penny candy, slush puppies, ice cream treats, camping supplies, firewood, and an inviting front porch with a glider! Open Memorial Day to Labor Day.

## WAGON RIDES

Enjoy a wagon ride around the grounds; plan one with a campfire or cookout! Available year round weather permitting, the wagon is pulled by a tractor. Make arrangements at least one week in advance. Call (920) 294-7347 to inquire about rates and reservations.
