

Each year about 100 of our volunteers enrich the experience that thousands of guests have at Green Lake Conference Center (GLCC)!

We seek volunteers with the following:

- ❖ A desire to perform service in a Christian environment *with a servant's heart* in order to support the mission of GLCC by enhancing programs and conferences, showing personal concern for guests, and assisting in whatever ways are needed.
- ❖ Skills, interests and experience in specific areas of need.
- ❖ Good physical health to carry out normal and routine tasks; physical stamina is required in many positions.
- ❖ Sufficient financial resources to volunteer a significant portion of time, maintain personal needs, and carry adequate medical and hospitalization insurance.
- ❖ A willingness to work 30 - 40 hours per week and a minimum of four weeks. Most volunteers serve about nine weeks, from May through September, our busiest time. Many are able to serve for longer periods.
- ❖ An acceptance that volunteers may be rotated in and out of the program in order to allow more GLCC friends to share in this meaningful experience.

Opportunities at other times of year:

For those who can commit to a one to three week block of time between January and May, GLCC is in need of maintenance help to keep up with projects and demands. We need those with carpentry, electrical, plumbing, painting, drywall, HVAC and other trade skills.

Rewards & Benefits of Volunteer Service

GLCC appreciates its volunteers and wants their stay here to be a rich and enjoyable experience. While providing invaluable service, volunteers may expect:

- An unlimited opportunity to make friends and establish lasting relationships.
- Staff rates for recreational facilities and services on the grounds.
- An invitation to participate in organized volunteer group activities.
- A deluxe lounge (called the Power Plant) exclusively for volunteer use including a large flat screen TV, computer with Internet connection, Wi-Fi access, kitchenette, lending library, comfortable couches and chairs and tables for playing games.
- Modest housing (some are not air conditioned)
 - Sometimes volunteers are required to share facilities.
 - RV parking/hook-ups are available for those with recreational vehicles.
 - Volunteer housing is one to two miles away, so you need your own transportation.

The selection process begins in September, matching applicants to positions with the intent of completing the process by December 31. Applicants will be advised of their status as soon as possible, but no later than April 1.
